

TOWNSHIP GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT – Resolution 2026-07

STANDISH TOWNSHIP

A resolution to establish a general appropriations act for Standish Township; to define the powers and duties of the Standish Township officers in relation to the administration of the budget; and to provide remedies for refusal or neglect to comply with the requirements of this resolution.

The Board of Trustees of Standish Township ordains (resolves):

Section 1: Title

This resolution shall be known as the Standish Township General Appropriations Act.

Section 2: Chief Administrative Officer

The Supervisor (or other designated official) shall be the Chief Administrative Officer and shall perform the duties of the Chief Administrative Officer enumerated in this act.

Section 3: Fiscal Officer

The Clerk (or other designated official) shall be the Fiscal Officer and shall perform the duties of the Fiscal Officer enumerated in this act.

Section 4: Public Hearings on the Budget

For general law townships: Pursuant to MCLA 141.412; MCLA 141.413, notice of a public hearing on the proposed budget was published in a newspaper of general circulation on March 19, 2026 must be at least six days prior to the public hearing], and a public hearing on the proposed budget was held on March 25, 2026.

Section 5: Estimated Revenues

Estimated township general fund revenues for fiscal year 2026-2027, including an allocated operating millage of .9955 mills, a voted road millage of .9955 mills, a PA 33(real only) fire millage of 1.0000 mills, and a mosquito control millage of 1.0000 mills (pending election 2026)

Section 6: Millage Levy

The Standish Township Board shall cause to be levied and collected the general property tax on all real and personal property within the township upon the current tax roll an amount equal to 2.9910 mills and on real property only an additional 1.0000 mills as set forth by the Tax Allocation Board (or as authorized under state law and approved by the electorate).
