

**Standish Township  
Mosquito Management  
Community Outreach Program 2026**

APM Mosquito Control (APM) has been contracted to provide mosquito control services for Standish Township. The program will consist of all phases of an Integrated Pest Management strategy against mosquitoes in the township.

1. Adult mosquito monitoring/Disease Surveillance Testing.
2. Breeding site inspection and larviciding.
3. ULV Adulticide applications.
4. Special events/Nuisance/Municipal Adulticide applications.

Detailed information about the program is available at the township offices. In an effort to notify residents within the township for community Larviciding and ULV adulticide applications, APM and Standish Township utilize the following methods:

1. Initially the township mails a postcard about the mosquito control program to every resident. The mailer explains how the whole program works and gives any residents the opportunity to opt out.
2. The township posts information about mosquito program at the township offices, in the newsletters, as well as the applicable township website, <https://standishtownship.gov/>
3. Public notice in newspaper. A notice appears in the local paper (Arenac Independent) explaining seasonal larviciding and seasonal adulticiding. Also allows anyone interested in further information to contact APM or the township office.
4. A Call/Shut-off notification list is maintained as part of the township program. Before ULV adulticide applications take place, APM will call any residents that request to remind them and inform them that a community mosquito control application will be happening that evening, weather permitting. Residents may

also request that the ULV adulticide be shut off in front of and or upwind of their area. These areas are staked and noted on ULV adulticide operational maps.

5. Mosquito control is often a topic of discussion at township meetings and residents are always encouraged to find out more about their local mosquito control program. APM holds open house events for residents at the request of the township. These events introduce the personnel assigned to service the area; provides an overview and demonstration of equipment used and information on materials used to provide mosquito control.
6. Information (sample labels & SDS) on insecticides used in the program are available upon request by calling the local APM office at (989) 426-2420 or the toll-free number (877) 276-4714.
